- <u>All Youth Leaders</u> please check temperatures of your attendees before coming to each service.
- <u>Masks should be worn inside buildings</u> in addition to maintaining other sanitizing protocols.
- Fit the mask snugly against the sides of your face, slipping the loops over your ears or tying the string behind your head
- Highly recommend elbow bumps and virtual hugs with others who don't live with you especially inside sanctuary.

Wash your hands often

"Best practice" Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds especially after you have been in a public place, or after blowing your nose, coughing, or sneezing, wash hands frequently,

- Before eating or preparing food
- Before touching your face
- After using the restroom
- After leaving a public place
- After blowing your nose, coughing, or sneezing
- After handling your mask
- After changing a diaper
- After caring for someone sick
- After touching animals or pets

Bring plenty of hand sanitizer. hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol.

• Hand sanitizer will be present

If soap and water are not readily available, use a hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol. Cover all surfaces of your hands and rub them together until they feel dry.

• Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands.

Cover coughs and sneezes

If you are wearing a mask: You can cough or sneeze into your mask. Put on a new, clean mask as soon as possible and wash your hands.

Always cover your mouth and nose with a tissue when you cough or sneeze, or use the inside of your elbow and do not spit.

Throw used tissues in the trash.
